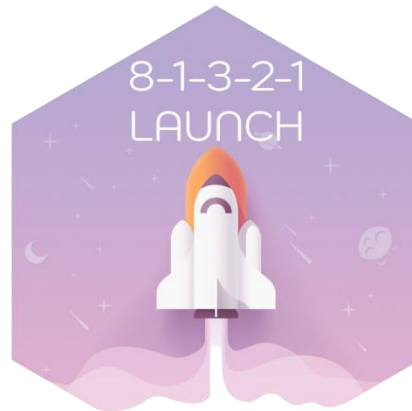


81321 LAUNCH OVERVIEW & APPLICATION QUESTIONS



81321 Launch is a creative project generator that gives community members a simple way to improve Cortez!

You can submit an idea at any time. Our grant committee will review the applications in April (applications due April 1), July (applications due July 1), and October (applications due October 1). We can award multiple projects per rounds, up to \$4,000, so we encourage all levels of funding to apply! We will use the following criteria when determining successful applicants:

Only projects that are based in Cortez, Colorado will be considered.

Additionally, there are a few uses of the funds that we will **NOT** consider:

- As seed funding for a for-profit start-up.
- Paying yourself or purchasing supplies that will solely benefit the project leader.
- Funding for a project as for-profit or sales that directly benefit the applicant or project lead.
